Established in 1992, the teacher in residence (TIR) became the vital link of the SESA program. Each year, an area teacher is granted a year's leave of absence from their home district to work with scientists at Husky Energy, INEOS, Fort Amanda Specialties, ISP and PotashCorp to coordinate the SESA calendar of events. The participating companies reimburse the school district for the annual cost of a substitute teacher. In return, all Allen County districts benefit from the coordination efforts of the TIR. The hosting district also benefits from the educational expertise the teacher brings back to the district.
