**University of Dayton**

**Cost of Attendance \$35,535**

- **At least \$15,000/yr** All students must have a minimum GPA of A **AND** a 32-36 ACT or 1430-1600 SAT (M+CR).
- **\$12,000/yr** All students must have a minimum GPA of A-AND a 29-36 ACT or 1310-600 SAT (M+CR).
- **\$10,000/yr** All students must have a minimum GPA of B+ **AND** a 27-29 ACT or 1230-1300 SAT (M+CR).
- **\$7,500/yr** All students must have a minimum GPA of B **AND** a 21-27 ACT or 1000-1220 SAT (M+CR).

**University Merit Scholarships**

Students with the grade point averages and test scores listed above are guaranteed scholarships within the ranges specified. Exact scholarship award amounts within each range will be determined by a holistic review of the application for admission and thorough evaluation of academic indicators including, but not limited to: rigor of coursework (based on courses available at high school), high school GPA, and standardized test scores. **Award determinations will be based on the official testing and high school transcript information received by Miami University as of March 1, 2014.**

In addition to these amounts listed, Miami awards scholarships based upon financial need (determined by the FAFSA), diversity, audition, portfolio, academic performance, athletic ability, and intended area of interest.

\* No preference is given for ACT or SAT, and Miami uses the highest test scores submitted. For ACT, the best composite score is used; for SAT, the best Critical Reading and Math sub-scores are used.

\*\* 90.0 or above GPA on a 100 scale. If a high school reports grades on both a 4.0 and a 100 point scale, Miami will always use the GPA on the 4.0 scale.

\*\*\* Final amount determined by rigor of coursework, high school GPA, and standardized test scores.

\*\*\*\* Based on Fall 2014 estimated tuition. Estimates are used for the four-year total value.

Scholarships are automatically renewed for four years, provided the student maintains the academic requirements as stipulated in the financial aid award letter.

## Ohio Northern University

**Cost of Attendance** \$45,898/yr

- **\$20,000/yr** Students must have an ACT score of at least 30 or an SAT score of at least 1330 AND a GPA of at least 3.5.
- **\$17,000/yr** Students must have an ACT score of at least 27 or an SAT score of at least 1210 AND a GPA of at least 3.5.
- **\$14,000/yr** Students must have an ACT score of at least 24 or an SAT score of at least 1090 AND a GPA of at least 3.3.

## Ohio University

**In-State Cost of Attendance** \$10,370/yr

**Out-of State Cost of Attendance** \$14,780/yr

- **Full in-state tuition/yr** award for GPA of at least 3.0 and SAT (M+CR) or ACT score of at least 1400 or 32, respectively.
- **\$4,000/yr** award for GPA of at least 3.0 and SAT (M+CR) or ACT score from 1360-1390 or 31, respectively.
- **\$2,000/yr** award for GPA of at least 3.0 and SAT (M+CR) or ACT score of 1320-1350 or 30, respectively.
- **\$1,500/yr** award for GPA of at least 3.0 and SAT (M+CR) or ACT score of 1280-1340 or 29, respectively.
- **\$1,000/yr** award for GPA of at least 3.0 and SAT (M+CR) or ACT score of 1240-1270 or 28, respectively.
- **\$750/yr** award for GPA of at least 3.0 and SAT (M+CR) or ACT score of 1200-1230 or 27, respectively.
- **\$500/yr** award for GPA of at least 3.0 and SAT (M+CR) or ACT score of 1130-1190 or 25-26, respectively.
