Applications must be signed by an authorized individual. Camp participants should be students identified in accordance with the State of Ohio Gifted and Talented identification guidelines. High performance may be manifested in any or a combination of these areas:

- Superior Cognitive Ability
- Specific Academic Ability
- Creative Thinking Ability
- Visual or Performing Arts

The student meets the Camp Inquire requirements because he/she (check any which apply):

- ___ a. has IQ of 125 or above.
- ___ b. has scored in the 95th percentile or better on an achievement test in the areas of Reading, Math, Science, Social Studies or Composite.
- ___ c. has been identified as possessing creative thinking ability commensurate with identification criteria established by approved individual or group test of creative ability or on an approved checklist of creative behaviors administered by a trained individual.
- ___ d. has been identified in Visual/Performing Arts.
- ___ e. is presently enrolled in the school gifted program.

The daily sessions will begin at 9:00 AM and conclude at 3:00 PM.

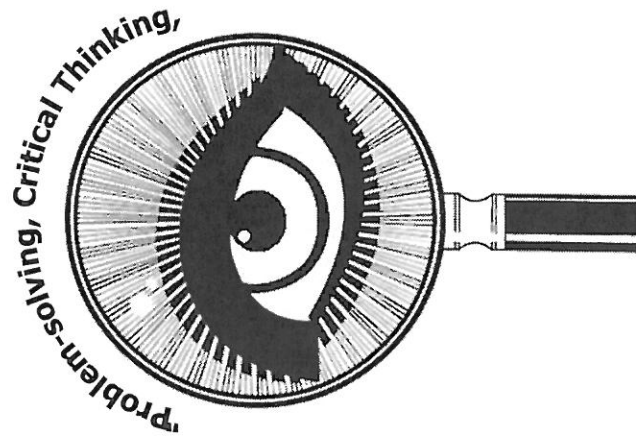
