

<b>Qualifications:</b>	<p>Certificate – Current Ohio Teaching Certificate with licensure in Gifted Education</p> <p>Experience – minimum of two years teaching experience. Such other alternatives as the Board may find appropriate and acceptable</p>
<b>Reporting To:</b>	Director of Gifted Services, Superintendent and/or designee
<b>Job Goals:</b>	To provide instructional services within a multi-disciplinary framework which goes beyond those normally provided for students of superior cognitive ability and/or specific academic ability.
<b>Performance Responsibilities:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To provide instruction for developing skills in higher level thinking (critical thinking, divergent thinking, logical reasoning, creative problem-solving), research methods, social/emotional skills, and oral/written expression;</li> <li>2. To provide services that may include advancement in a specific academic discipline, investigation of aesthetic appreciation, career investigation, independent study, and guidance;</li> <li>3. To know, understand and apply Ohio's Learning Standards to gifted instruction;</li> <li>4. To provide appropriate instructional leadership for gifted services;</li> <li>5. To participate on identification committees for the purpose of placement, evaluation, and reassignment of children;</li> <li>6. To provide communication, evaluation, and reporting of student progress to parents;</li> <li>7. To consult and collaborate with classroom teachers, school administrators, and community members;</li> <li>8. To participate in the personal evaluation with the gifted director and building administrators;</li> <li>9. To provide records that are appropriate for reporting gifted services;</li> <li>10. To follow the policy of the school district of attendance regarding the administering of medication;</li> <li>11. To attend professional workshops and/or conferences pertaining to gifted education;</li> <li>12. Such other duties as may be assigned by the Director of Gifted Services and/or Superintendent.</li> </ol>
<b>Physical/Mental/ Work Hazards</b>	Works in school buildings under a fast paced sometimes stressful environment requiring standing, walking, lifting, bending, reaching, pulling, and grasping
<b>Travel Requirements</b>	Travel to school buildings, city/state agencies, and professional meetings as required. Teachers may need to utilize their own transportation and move instructional materials.
<b>Evaluation:</b>	Performance of this job will be evaluated in accordance with provisions of the Allen County Board policy on evaluation of certificated personnel.
